

Honduras 23 of August, 1984.

Dear Daddy, finally I'm getting around to writing. I must apologise that in the last 2 weeks I have not written anything. Over two weeks ago I left Venezuela on a trip to Central America going through practically all the countries in the area. At the moment I am here in Honduras and in about 10 days more we hope to be back in Venezuela.

It has been a long trip and also a tiring one as we are having a lot of meetings particularly with the families of the disappeared. They are now well organized in most of these countries & finally their voices are being heard. The worst situation is in the countryside particularly where there is war & they are many victims particularly in the countryside.

How is everyone at home? I imagine you are all very busy with the summer work. I hope the weather is fine.

And the sight? I'm sure you are getting better all the time. One has to be patient with cataracts. When I get a chance I'll write a longer letter. For the summer holidays the best Best wishes to all at home your brother
