Re: Amendments on Argentina and the Philippines in the Foreign Operations Subcommittee of the House Appropriations Committee

On Monday, May 23rd, two human rights amendments will be introduced in the Foreign Operations Subcommittee of the House Appropriations Committee. One by Rep. Yvonne Burke of California, will reduce the overall program to the Philippines. The second, by Rep. Edward Roybal, also of California, would eliminate the military training program for Argentina.

The existence of these amendments is the product of the hard work of the human rights lobby here in Washington. However, both are deeply endangered by an all-out counter-lobby conducted by the State Department, the Defense Department and President Carter himself, all of whom are advancing the well-known "flexibility" argument and are seeking to stop any further human rights initiative by Congress.

We have learned that President Carter himself is contacting members of this subcommittee to urge them not to vote for these two amendments. His meeting with Reps. Stokes (D-Ohio) and Yates (D-Ill.) have apparently already had the effect of weakening their willingness to go on record in these key human rights votes. Yates abstained during the vote Friday to cut aid to Nicaragua and Stokes absented himself.

We urge you to call or telegram the following members of the subcommittee on Friday or over the weekend to urge them to support the Burke amendment on the Philippines and the Roybal amendment on Argentina:
