Gunmen grab young couple

THE young parents of a 20-day-old baby have disappeared after being seized by unidentified gunmen, it was revealed yesterday by the grandparents who are caring for the child.

The apparent kidnapping was denounced in a writ of habeas corpus filed by Mr and Mrs Cayetano Pellegrini who said that their daughter, Liliana Mareela, 21, and her husband, Carlos Gregorio Lordkipanidse, have not been traced since they were taken away by a group of men

in Ford Falcons on November 18 at about 5.30pm.

Also seized with the couple were their son, Rodolfo, who was born on October 24, and their young cousin Cristian Anibal Colombo. But Colombo was released that evening and brought back the baby in his arms to his grandparents.

The kidnapping took place when the young mother was returning with her husband, the baby and Colombo from her parents house at Muñiz

1040 to their own home at Humberto 1° 1319, where they live in apartment A on the third floor. The men intercepted the taxi at the corner of Muñiz and Venezuela.

In the habeas corpus writ Mr and Mrs Pellegrini said that the couple's flat was ransacked later and everything taken away — including objects of little value — in two trucks.
