the Newspapers. Perhaps it would be better not to send so many
newspapers to the New address.

Hope that Mammey has recovered from the diabetes & Kitty &
Liam are well again. I am glad the summer was nice in
weather and I imagine the harvest went very well. Sorry for not
writing more often. Between one thing and another I never get around to it
& when I've some time I start chatting with the others here & before
I know where I am the time is gone. You seem to be getting on very
well in the Rowing. I hope you will be able to get the new boat. I saw
that an Irishman came second in the World Skulling championships
recently. I said in the paper that he was favorite.

As you mentioned in the letter the violence in Argentina is
really bad. We I suppose being here don't notice it too much but it
really is very bad. In one province there is practically a war on between
a young socialist group who are living in the mountains & the
Army. Most days there are 2 or 3 deaths at least & no one seems
to bother too much. What has happened in Spain with Franco is nothing
in comparison with the activity of some police groups here and worse
still in Chile.

I suppose you've started back already at school.
I'm glad you don't have to press yourself too much for the
Leaving. It is the best way not doing things to extreme. You're
right at saying that it would be best some more study after-
wards. There is no hurry - one can begin one thing & if that
does not work out one can always change.

I wonder if you do me a favour I have to do some paper work in order to renew my papers here so I wonder if you or someone at home get my birth certificate. I think in the County Council in Cork or Dublin. This certificate then has to be legalised by the Argentinian embassy in Dublin. In a telephone directory the street should be. It was near Booterstown before. They stamp the Birth Cert. as legalised. I think it is free. So you could send the cert. by post or perhaps some friend who is in Dublin. I will include a note for the Embassy. You can then send it to me.

How is everyone at home. Mamma I hope is taking care of herself. This weekend we are going to the country for a day or 2. The city is not joke after a while. The work is going well & now I'm getting used to it. After a while you forget about the height. Also most of the time I work with another making the stairs. We have a tremendous view of Bs As from the building as you can imagine.

Well Dennis I'll finish this letter. It's a good while since I wrote & I've been tipping at this letter for a good while doing it in bits & pieces. Hope it finds everyone well. Keep writing to the same address. I will send another address shortly for newspapers etc.
