P.S. - I had a recent letter from some French sisters who have two of their Community (Srs. Alicia Domon and Renee Duquet) disappeared in Argentina since December 1977. Perhaps you could also remember them. As the Sisters have no clear evidence of their reported deaths, they are pursuing the question.

For those of you who do not know me, I am a member of the Fraternity who worked in Argentina for some years. I was Superior of the Community to which these priests belonged or were directly related. I was imprisoned and deported for Christmas 1976 and since that time have worked with "Amnesty" and other Human Rights Groups here and in Europe (I am Irish) not only on these cases for which I feel a special responsibility but also for other disappeared. I am currently assigned to Jamaica but will spend some months here on this issue.
