I'm inclosing 2 slides - One was taken in Anturman around April - it was a walk we done with a Legion of Mary-type group to in the country here - you can see us having the lunch - With the same group of people we're organising the youth week here. Most are University & secondary school students. The other photo was taken during Winter when 2 of us went fishing on the river here. The water of the river is salted & and for that no vegetation grows on the banks - It was about 11.0 in the morning when ~~we~~ he took the photo. The sky here is mostly blue like that. I didn't come out too well because of the sun. About 2 hrs. later the owner of the farm came & and hunted us ... - we weren't supposed to be there!
