I wrote to her a week or so ago so she should have received my letter. I got two packages of papers and one with 5 pound and the letter with 5 thank you very much. It is really better to let the money in Ireland as it can always be useful to pay travel expenses.

You asked me about the situation of returning to Ireland - if it the same or different with the Little Brothers. In fact it is somewhat different as it is left to everyone to decide more or less when to visit his family. For that reason some return every 4 years others stay much longer. In that case I will go back for a Holiday in 1975. In May or June this year I will know more exactly as then I will finish my time here in La Rioja and I will know when I will return to Olmos or not. How are all the relatives keeping? I hope the winter is'nt too cold. It seems to be aweful problem with the Petrol, Luckily here Argentina produces almost all of its own fuel as it has large deposits many more which they have yet to discover.

I better finish this letter as I never will. I was bringing it around in my pocket and so it got somewhat dirty. I'm sorry to hear Sam is sick I will send him shortly a letter. I hope he gets fixed up in life alright. If he wants to get married he has to look around for a girl with he can get on with and that she can get on with him. It should never be a matter of marry at any cost with anyone but I expect he will settle down one way or another.

How are all the rest keeping? Give my greetings to Dad & all. Sorry to hear that Jacks finding the going tough. Things in Argentina are a bit unsettled again politically. I have no other news except health wise I'm keeping very well and the sickness I had did not come back.
