In the letters to Mummy I commented of my visit home that it would be earlier than I thought. Finally I have been able to confirm the ticket. It is for the 4<sup>th</sup> March which is really quite near. I have booked it on credit so that I will pay it when I return in June. I was trying to get it directly to Cork but it was impossible. I don't know yet the timetable but I should arrive early on the 5<sup>th</sup> if not the 4<sup>th</sup>. The firm with which I travel is Aerolineas Argentinas & the flight is direct from Bs. As. to London. In London I will probably take the train & ferry to Cork.

In order to pay that perhaps in the next letter you write to me you could send on a note of £10. I don't imagine it would cost more than £15 & I have £5. Putting it in the letter & sending it to the address in Bs. As. it should arrive without any trouble. I will send that letter as soon as possible. If this letter arrives late don't worry as I will be able to buy some £5 before leaving.

How is everyone? No doubt you will be able to inform the relations of my coming. I will write to Kathy Noonan in London and to other friends in Ireland. Marie Fitzpatrick didn't arrive & I have no news of them so I will write to her parents to send on a letter there as they will know where they are. The postal service between Mexico & here is very bad at the moment.
